**Silver Spring, MD**—Three Montgomery Blair 2014 graduates were named to Spring 2014 All-Met sports teams by the *Washington Post* on June 15. Adrienne Kehne of Takoma Park was named to the All-Met Girls’ Rowing First Team, Annie Pietanza of Silver Spring was named to the All-Met Softball Second Team, and Neil Gahart of Kensington was named as an All-Met Honorable Mention in Baseball. Gahart and Kehne are 2014 graduates of the Montgomery Blair High School Science, Mathematics, and Computer Science Magnet Program.

Three times a year in fall, winter, and spring, the *Washington Post* invites coaches from more than 250 schools in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area to nominate top athletes from their sports. Using this information, the newspaper’s scholastic sports staff selects the best high school athletes to form virtual teams for various sports with the categories of First Team, Second Team, Honorable Mention, various Players of the Year, and Coach of the Year. Twenty-nine sports have been represented throughout the year since 1990.
